



D.O.T. Pipeline Transfer of Operations Management of Change (MOC)

In an effort to develop MOC documentation to allow the operational transfer of off-site refinery pipelines to a third party operating company, DPSI was chosen by Big West of California (BWoC) to provide project management services.

DPSI's scope of work included:

- Development of Management of Change (MOC) documentation
- Definition of purpose of MOC
- Development of the operational execution plan
- Research and recording of pipeline specification data and commodity
- Piping specification and line numbers
- Piping design
- Operational pressure/temperature
- Commodity source and motive data
- Block valve and location and tagging system
- Over-pressure protection devices
- Creation of the pipeline route description
- Development of the Emergency Response Procedure
- Verification of offsite pipe rooting to determine correct line tagging/markings sequence

In order to complete this work successfully, DPSI worked closely with BWoC's D.O.T. Coordinator, plant engineers, environmental engineers, and operations staff.
