At the time Pacific Energy acquired the three offshore Platforms Elly, Ellen, and Eureka, they also inherited over thirty years of records, reports, drawings, and documents from Aera Energy relating to the platforms and the San Pedro Bay Pipeline.

DPSI was assigned the following tasks:

- Cataloging and marking the records
- Storing the records
- Tracking the records
- Scanning and preservation of the original construction drawings and vendor submittals
- Design of electronic infrastructure for easy access to both electronic and hard copy documents

DPSI assembled a document control team who developed an innovative document control library and system. The team unpacked, reviewed, scanned, and stored each document for ease of location.

DPSI also developed a cost tracking system to track approximately 25 separate projects with a total budget of over ten million dollars. The cost tracking system monitored original budget, supplements to the budget, revised budget, cost to date, percent expended, percent complete, cost to complete, and estimated final cost. Cost was tracked on a weekly basis with real-time estimates from all subcontractors to stay one step ahead of the actual numbers hitting the accounting department budgets.
